WHY TAKE THIS COURSE?

WHAT ARE THE KEY TOPICS IT WILL COVER?

You will be reinforcing the basic methods and techniques involved in producing more challenging landscape paintings, colour mixing, brush control and application, wet in wet and dry brush techniques, monochrome painting and painting with a limited palette will be repeated, as repetition leads to retention of information, the more you repeat, the better you become. Some of the topics that will be covered include landscape painting with; skies, trees, figures, flowers, buildings, water and reflections. You will also get the chance to learn how to paint coastal/beach scenes, still life and flower paintings.

WHO WILL THE COURSE SUIT?

Beginners and improving painters, but not 'absolute beginners'. You must however be 19 years or above to do this course.

IS THERE A QUALIFICATION AT THE END OF THE COURSE?

No. There are no formal assessments but you will be given an Individual Learning Plan and you will find key objectives for the course. You will be asked if you have any of your own personal learning objectives and your tutor will try to accommodate these topics if at all possible.
